

EMEYF Charitable Committee Job Description

EMEYF receives much of its funding from Quaker Trusts, many of which are in the UK. Some of these can only give money to registered charities. The EMEYF Charitable Committee has been set up and registered as a charity to facilitate this fundraising activity. The EMEYF UK Charitable Treasurer is ultimately responsible for convening the committee, maintaining the UK bank accounts, fundraising within the UK, and communicating with the UK Government Charities Commission. However, all committee members are trustees, and therefore legally responsible for the activities of the committee (in other words, making sure the Charitable Treasurer does their job!). The committee meets once a year at Annual Meeting. Members should take an interest in the activities of EMEYF and EMEYF Charitable Committee, try to attend Annual Meeting, keep a watch for any new funding opportunities, and support the activities of the Charitable Treasurer as needed. Members of the Charitable Committee do not necessarily have to be from the UK.
